The Women's Treatment Center (TWTC) hopes you are well and that you will partner with us to positively impact a vulnerable population of Chicago's women and children during this stressful time of the COVID-19 pandemic, and its aftermath.

In accordance with the Department of Homeland Security Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency memorandum ("Identification of Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers During COVID-19 Response"), TWTC provides essential services to women in treatment for substance use. As a 24/7 residential facility, essential employees are required to manage and maintain TWTC's programs for Residential Treatment, Methadone Medication Treatment, and transitional living in its Recovery Homes. As the city of Chicago grapples with the spread of COVID-19, women with addiction and their children face unprecedented stress resulting in an increased resurgence of illicit substance use, domestic violence, and child neglect and abuse. Especially now, TWTC needs your support to adequately tend to the need of this population that is unsheltered, overlooked and underserved.
